Unsupported by family, victims of addiction, street Youth, Young unmarried mothers, exprisoners, Young people with disabilities, Young prisoners, migrants...

## CREATE LIFE PROJECT CENTERS & DEVELOP AN INTEGRATION ECOSYSTEM

- The Life Project Centers are Micro Economic Initiative (MEI) incubators.
   They are located near slum areas
- The Young Adults make a commitment by joining a 15 Youth team, enrolled in "Professional Training for Entrepreneurs", for a 12-month training period (5 days a week, 8 hours a day), +6 months in a company
- Each Youth receives a weekly allowance that enables him/her to follow « Professional Training for Entrepreneurs »
- Each program is supported by partners: academic, business, NGOs, local government units and individuals.

### RESULTS

Of the +600 Youth who have benefitted from PTE:

- 80% have found decent employment
- 5% have set up their own micro-company
- 15% left the PTE before completing the program, but more than half of these returned within 6 months
